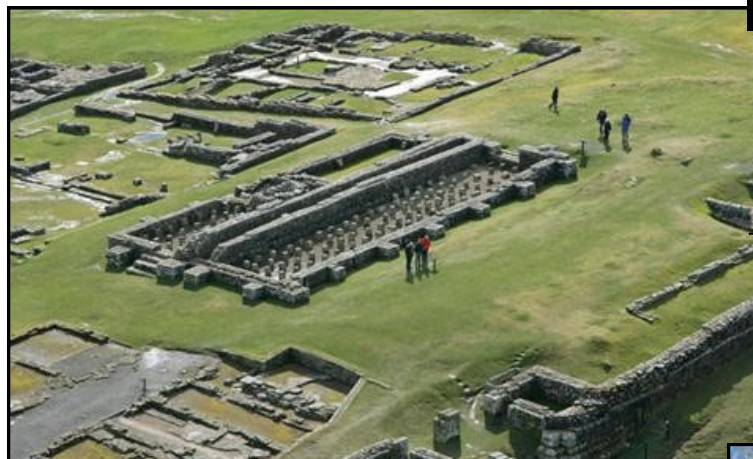


VINDOLANDA.

One of the most exciting archaeological sites in Europe. Live excavations April—September. Objects from the deep past including textiles, leather goods, wooden objects and flora and fauna have all survived thanks to the exceptional conditions found at Vindolanda. ROMAN ARMY MUSEUM

An authentic tribute to Rome's extraordinary military legacy. . Explored through reconstructions, objects excavated along Hadrian's Wall and the Vindolanda Trust's inspiring interpretations of army life including the exclusive 3D Edge of Empire film, Joint tickets available with Vindolanda..



HOUSESTEADS ROMAN FORT

Most spectacularly located of all the Hadrian's wall forts. Stunning views, explore natural wilderness and become immersed in the history. . Walk alongside the wall to Milecastle 37 and Sycamore Gap—famous as the location for much of the filming of "Robin Hood Prince of Thieves"- An English Heritage and National Trust Site.

LANERCOST PRIORY

Evocative site. No Roman Wall here as the stone was robbed for the building of the Priory! Early example of recycling in a pre-heritage conscious era! Look for the Centurial Stone—clearly visible, but incorporated into the stonework upside down! Plenty of archeology here, but part of the Priory still functions as the parish church—as, indeed it has been for 850 years. King Edward I ruled from here for six months in the winter 1306 -07 . Excellent restaurant and gift shop. English Heritage site



HALTWHISTLE GOLF CLUB welcomes individual and club visitors to this unique 18 hole course in spectacular scenery straddling Hadrian's Wall at the confluence of The Pennine Way and the Hadrian's Wall Trail. There is even a Roman Camp on the course and Roman road, Maidens Way, bisects the course. 5532 yards PAR 71
